## Steps



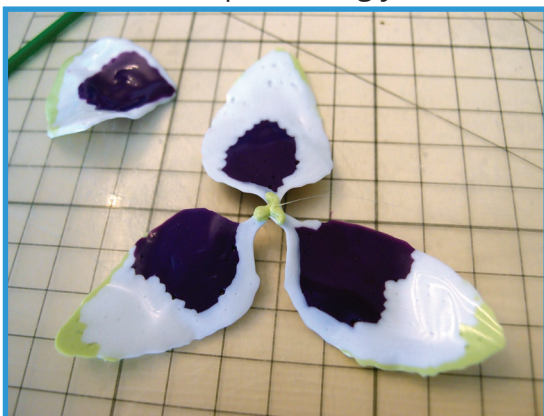
Fill in the stencils colour by colour. Doodle as much blossoms as you want!  
It is important to use PLA; all pieces are going to be shaped with hot air!



Put all parts onto a sheet of aluminium foil. Let the leaves bake in your oven in the middle section at 180 °C for about 10 minutes. Keep watching your work!



Now you'll net your hair-dryer!  
Heat up the leaves gently and bend them with your fingers into shape.



Assemble the bottom leaves, if necessary, at their back.



Turn them over and „glue“ the second pair of leaves onto them. A tiny dot will do the trick!



Set in the last piece of the orchid and „glue“ it with some plastic onto the bigger leaves.



Add the stem.



Repeat the steps for every blossom.



Adjust your blossoms to a strand of green PLA - you may bend it a little bit by using your hair drier again!



Now it's time to place your never-withering orchids into a nice vase :)
