




Using this stencil you can create your very own Tyranosaurus Rex skeleton. Fill in all the pieces and then put them together piece by piece just like a real paleontologist!





Step 1



Print out the stencil and trace the pieces. If the pieces are too flimsy go back over them.

Step 3





Next, attach the ribs to the spine going from small to big to small.

Step 2




Start with the two halves of the head, attach them at the nose. Keep the backs of the head separate.

Step 4



Attach the skull to the spine.


Step 6



Now attach the hips to the spine and ribs. then connect the pelvic bones.












Step 7




Attach the shoulders to either side of the ribs near the neck.

Step 9




Now attach the legs to the hips. Make sure they're evenly spaced.

Next, attach the arms to the shoulder blades.

Finally, attach the feet making sure when you secure them in place the T-Rex will be balanced to stand up.
