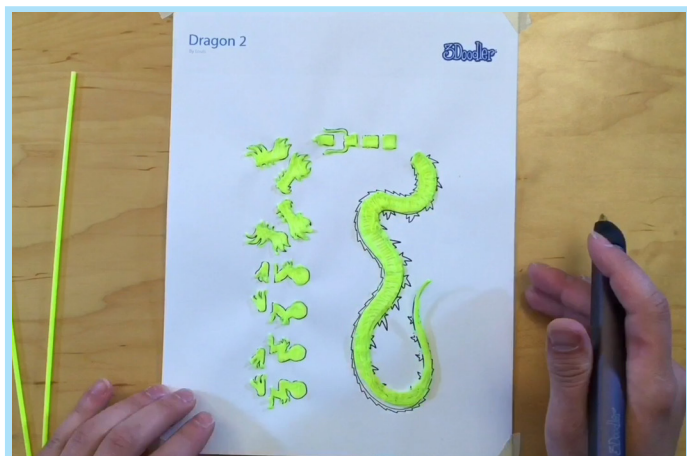
You'll eventually need a fearless knight to duel the beast as well... Good thing you have your 3Doodler!

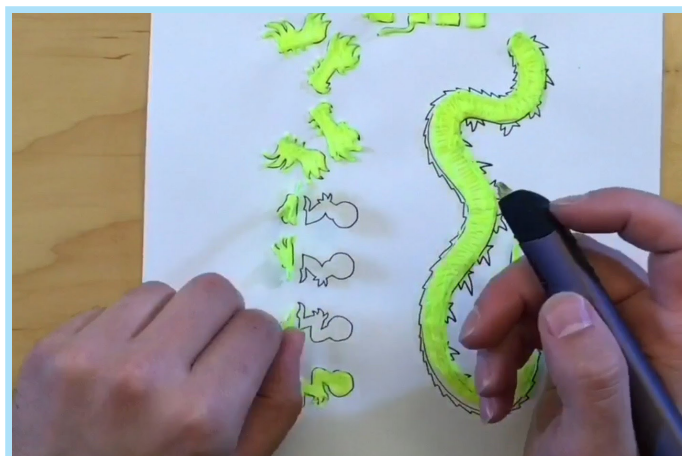


Step 1



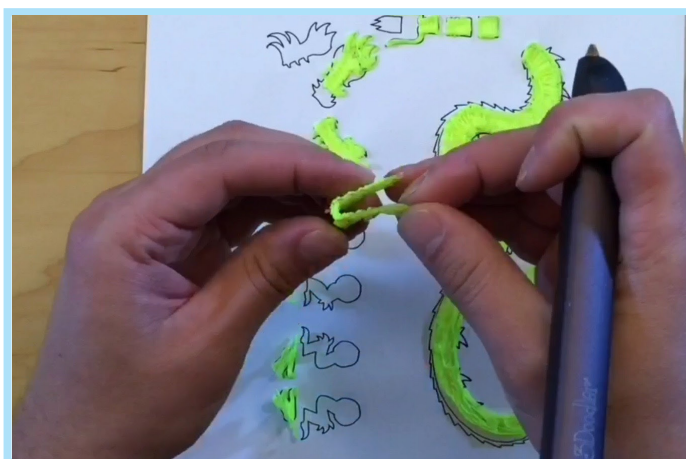
Print out the stencil, trace the pieces and fill them in

Attach the legs to the feet.

Step 3



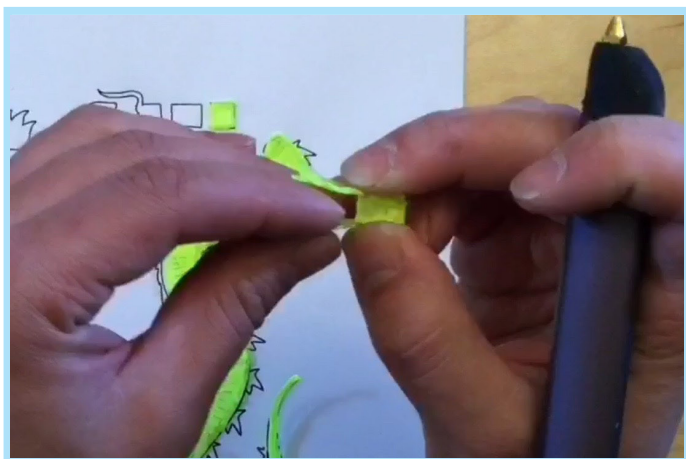
Assemble the halves of the head with the rectangles as the top of the snout and head

Step 4



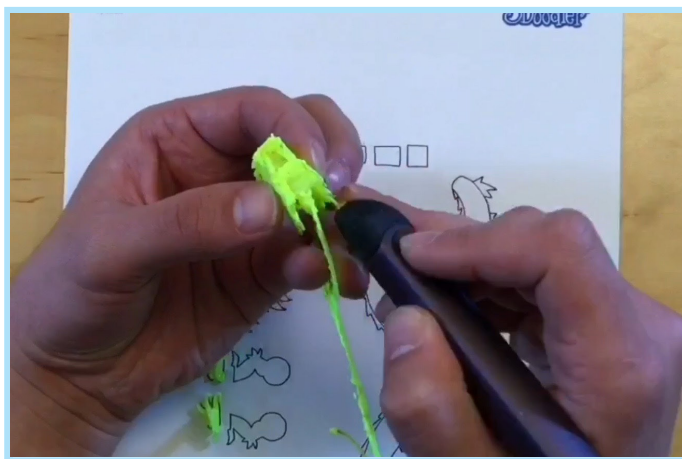
Don't forget the front of the nose with the mustache.

Assemble the lower jaw the same way and attach it to the top of the head.

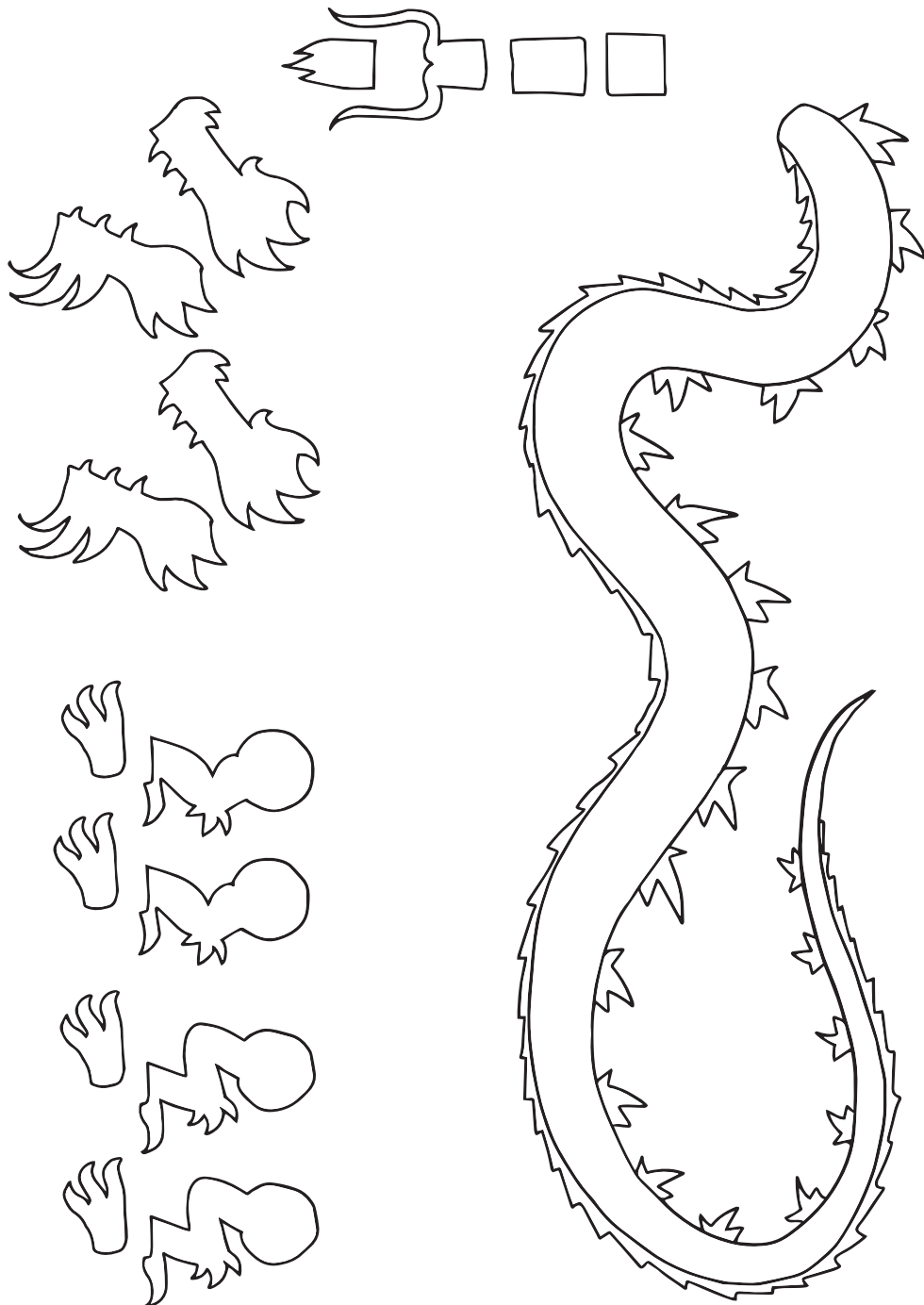
Step 6

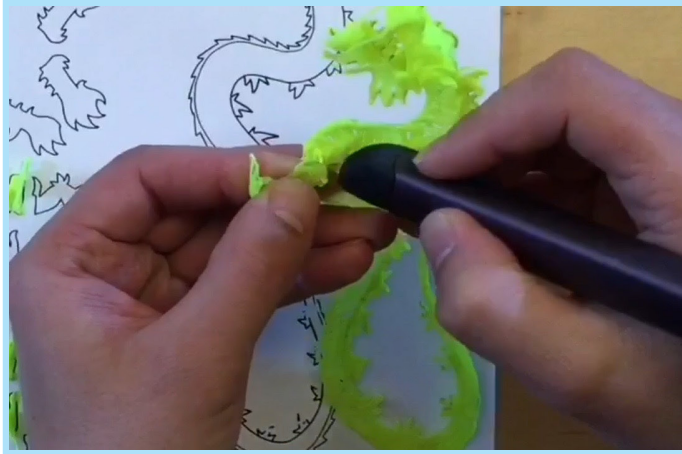

Step 7



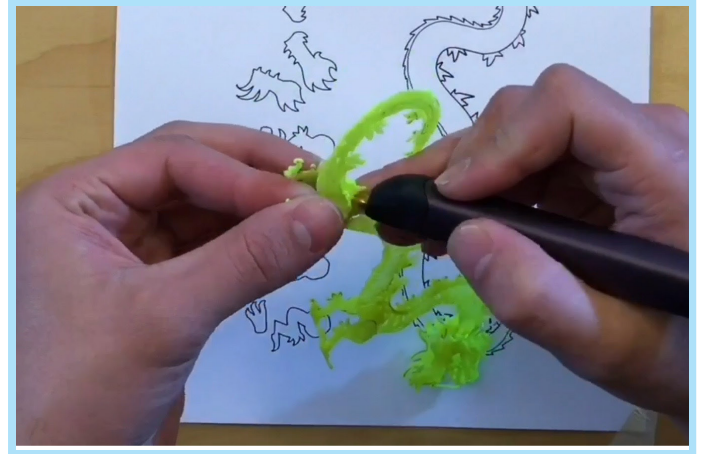
Attach the legs to the body giving a little distance so they're spread apart.
