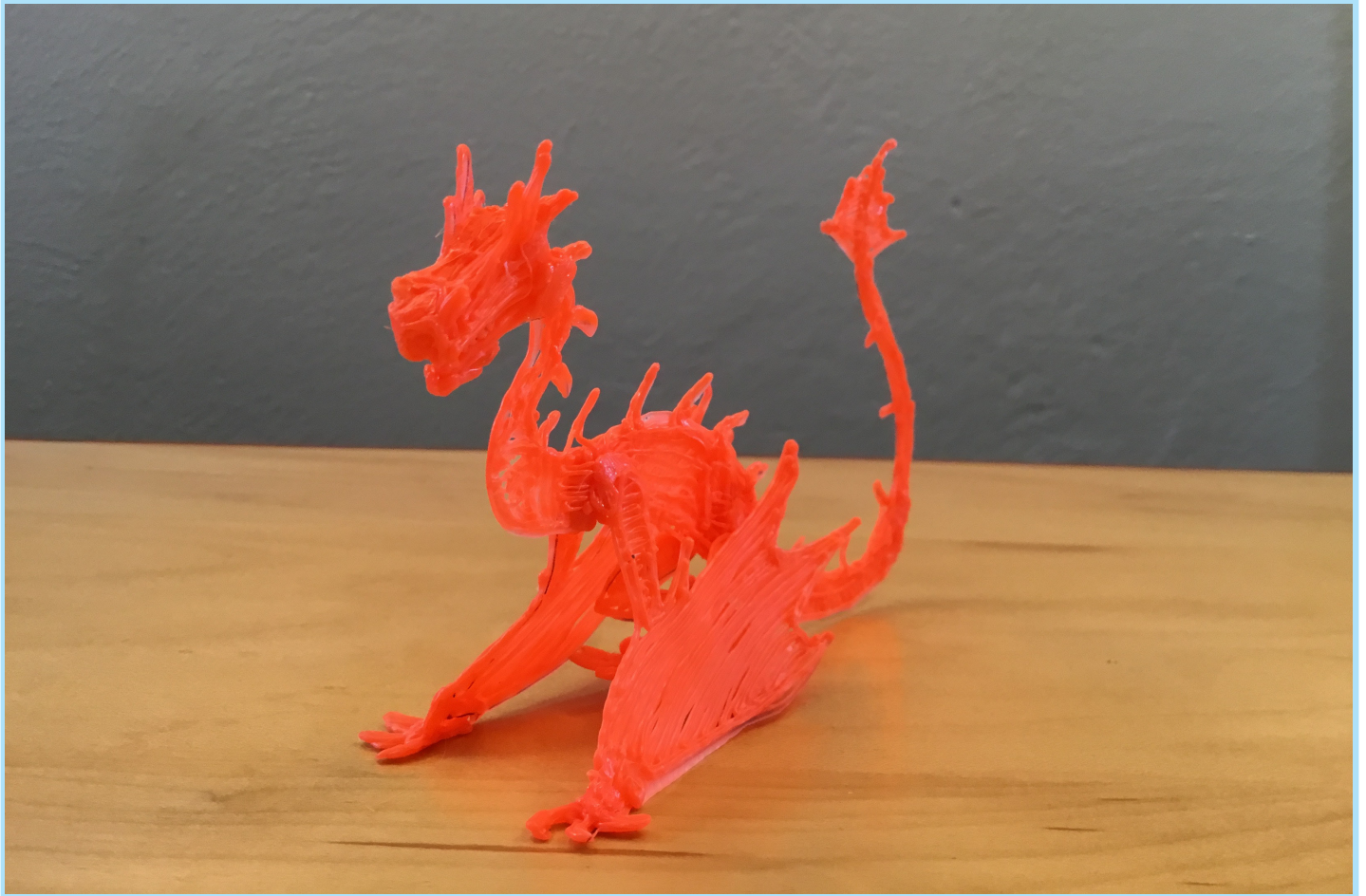


# Dragon 3

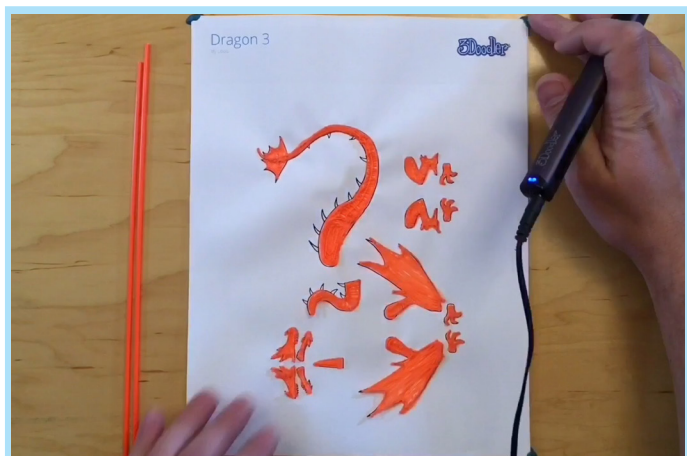
You'll eventually need a fearless knight to duel the beast as well... Good thing you have your 3Doodler!

## Step 1



Print out the stencil, trace the pieces and fill them in.

## Step 2



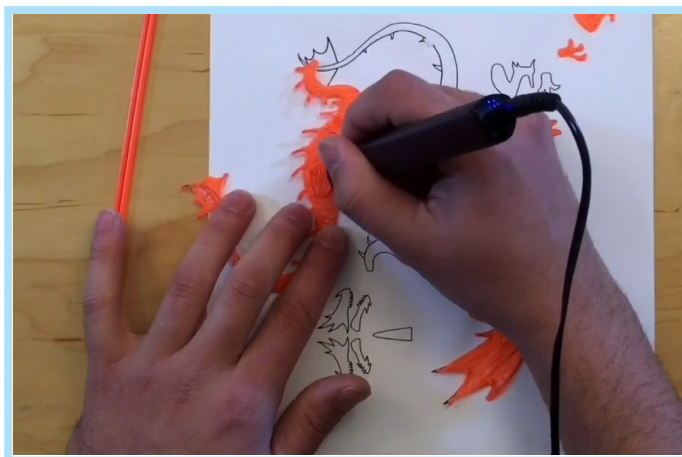
Attach the two sides of the head at the nose in the shape of a "V". Attach the sides of the jaws the same way.

## Step 3



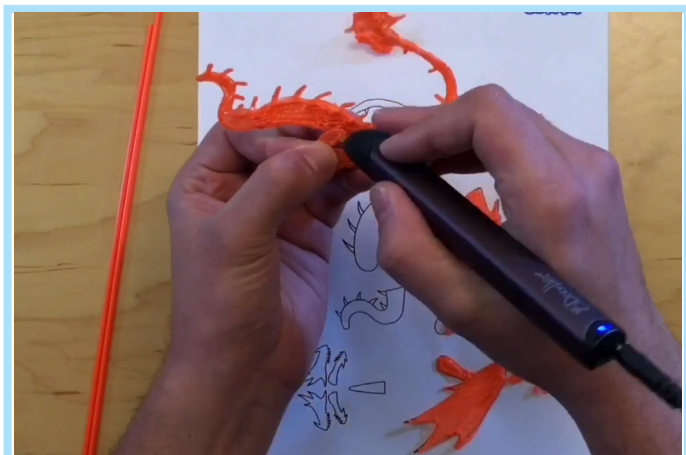
Attach the neck to the body. Don't forget to reinforce the other side.

## Step 4



Build up plastic at the shoulders and hips.

## Step 5



Attach feet to the back legs and legs to the body, making sure they're even and spread out a bit.

## Step 6



Now attach the arms at the shoulders, making sure they're even with the back legs.

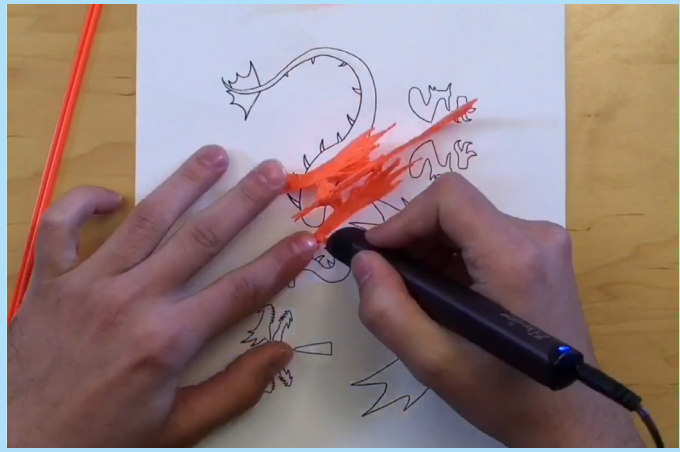

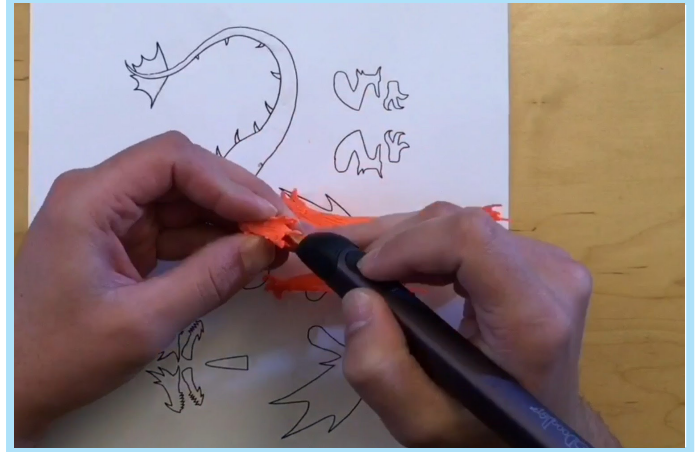


## Step 7



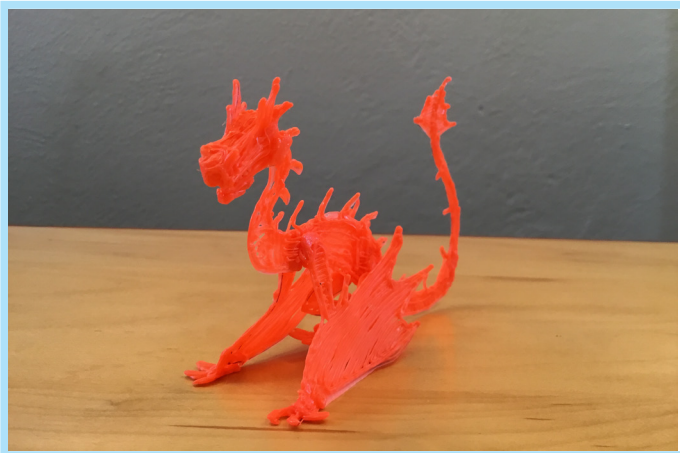
Now, add the front claws.
