







Let's start with F1 the lowest layer first. Stick the plastic tape on your printed template.

Adjust the mask so it will fit your face

Step 5




Draw checked pattern as foundation.

Step 2




place a curved object underneath the mask to avoid making the mask flat

Step 4




Start by doodling around the edges of the mask

Step 6



Doodle all exposed areas, as the rest of the mask will be covered by additional doodled areas

Step 9



Color it with the direction of fur grows.

Step 11




Remove the paper and doodle in the remaining areas

Step 8



Take off the paper of F2 and stick it on F1.

Step 10




Doodle around the edges

Step 12




Stick it on the mask symmetrically.






Roughly cut out E1 & E2, fold and glue it like this.

Step 15




Stick the ears on the back.

Step 17



Roughly cut out N1, fold and glue it like this.

Step 14



Fill up the space and freehand draw another layer on it.

Step 16



The mask should look like this now.

Step 18



Doodle in the remaining areas





Stick it on the mask carefully.

Step 21




Freehand draw another layer on it.

Step 23




Stick it on the mask.

Step 20



Also, do the same way at the back.

Step 22



Roughly cut out N2, draw the outline and color it.

Step 24



If you wish, you can freehand any additional details





Freehand draw a nose on the mask and color it.

Step 26



Finally use a string on the edges of the mask! Happy Halloween
